## Wildwood Hunting Preserve LLC Code of Conduct

The aim of Wildwood Hunting Preserve is to provide hunters with a quality, enjoyable, and safe hunting experience. To insure this environment for all of our hunters, Wildwood Hunting Preserve expects all hunters to abide by the following guidelines. Your guide will provide a full explanation of these rules prior to entering the field to hunt. Failure to comply with these guidelines on a hunt may result, at the discretion of our guides, a non-refundable end to your hunt and time at Wildwood Hunting Preserve:

- Listen to and respect your hunting guide at all times. It is the goal of our guides to insure you
  have a successful, enjoyable, and safe hunt. Your cooperation will allow them to succeed in
  providing this to you.
- 2) To insure the safety of our dogs, all shots must be made on birds to the level of the shooters shoulder or higher. No shots will be allowed across the front of your guide or behind you.
- 3) If you injure one of Wildwood Hunting Preserve's bird dogs due to a gunshot, you will agree to pay Wildwood Hunting Preserve \$3000 and the hunt will be concluded with no refund so that we may care for the health of our dog.
- 4) During transportation in the field, all vehicle or quail wagon occupants must be seated at all times and wear proper safety belts.
- 5) Only break open shotguns (over-under, side-by-sides, or single shot), 20 gauge or smaller, may be used during quail hunts. No semiautomatics or pumps allowed. Guns may only be loaded and ready to fire after the direction of your guide. Upon completion of a flush of quail, guns must be broken back open.
- All hunters must wear safety orange vests at all times in the field. Safety orange hats are optional but recommended.
- 7) Hunters waiting at the vehicle for their turn to hunt must not wander more than 20 yards away from the vehicle at any time.
- 8) No littering
- 9) No fires or sparks on the property, including smoking cigarettes, cigars, or pipes.
- 10) No Alcohol or Drugs. Wildwood reserves the right, based on the judgment of our guide to refuse a hunt or end a hunt, without a refund, for anyone suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- 11) If at any point our guide feels unsafe in the field with you or a member of your hunting party, he or she reserves the right to bring about the end of the entire hunt or any individuals hunt.

By signing this Code of Conduct you agree to abide by the rules of Wildwood Hunting Preserve LLC and the consequences contained therein.
